



## **Statutes regulating the imposition of tuition fees in the postgraduate English language Master Online Program “Advanced Oncology”**

**of 19 November 2009**

On the grounds of § 2(2) sentence 1, and 13(1) of the State Law on Tuition in Higher Education (“Landeshochschulgebührengesetz” = LHGebG) of 19 December 2005 (Law Gazette of 27 December 2005 p. 794 ff), last amended by article 2 of the Second Law on the Implementation of the Reform of Federalism in Higher Education (“Zweites Gesetz zur Umsetzung der Förderalismusreform im Hochschulbereich”) of 3 December 2008 (Law Gazette, p. 435 ff), the Senate of Ulm University adopted the following statutes on 12 November 2009. The President approved the statutes pursuant to § 2(2) sentence 2 LHGebG on 19 November 2009.

### **Preliminary remark on the use of language**

According to Article 3, par. 2 of the German Constitution, women and men have equal rights; all male designations of persons and positions in these statutes apply to women and men in the same way.

### **§ 1 Tuition fees**

Ulm University imposes tuition fees on the postgraduate English language Master Online Program “Advanced Oncology”. The imposition of fees, contributions to administrative costs, expenses and remunerations pursuant to sections 1 (2) and 12, 16, 18 and 19 LHGebG as well as contributions under the Student Services Act (“Studentenwerkgesetz”) remain unaffected.

### **§ 2 Amount of tuition fees and exemption from the obligation to pay fees**

- (1) The tuition fee shall be charged per semester. It amounts to €4,875 per semester or part thereof.
- (2) Periods of academic leave of absence are not subject to fees. The regulations of the admission and enrolment statutes of Ulm University in the respective valid version apply to academic leaves of absence.

### **§ 3 Compulsory tuition fees**

Students applying for enrolment in the Master Online Program are subject to tuition fees.

### **§ 4 Due date**

The fee falls due when the tuition fee notice is issued.

### **§ 5 Refund**

Should a student terminate his or her studies by withdrawing or changing their study course during the semester, the tuition fee shall be refunded provided that the lecture period has not yet started at the time of termination.

### **§ 6 Payment in instalments, extension or remission of payment**

On application and subject to section 59(1) no. 1 and 3 of the state budget regulations (LHO), the university may grant payment in instalments or extension or remission of payment. Applications must be submitted before the beginning of the lecture period.

### **§ 7 Date of effect**

These statutes shall take effect on the day after publication in the Official Bulletin ("Amtliche Bekanntmachungen") of Ulm University. They shall first apply in the winter semester of 2010/2011.
