



The **Faculty of Engineering, Computer Science and Psychology** at Ulm University in Germany invites applications for an

**Assistant Professor Position (W1) in Media Informatics (with Tenure Track)**

in the Institute of Media Informatics. The requirements for an appointment to a Full Professorship (W3 o.L.) after six years are outlined in the quality management concept of the University of Ulm.

The successful candidate should extend the existing teaching and research scope of the Institute of Media Informatics through complementary topics. The research focus of this professorship should extend the research focus "cognitive systems and human-machine interaction" of the faculty, a contribution to the collaborative research center "a companion technology for cognitive technical systems" (SFB/TRR 62) is desired.

We seek an individual with a passion for teaching who is qualified to offer courses in our Computer Science programs (e.g. Media Informatics, Computer Science or Cognitive Systems), both at the B.Sc. and M.Sc. level. Basic-level instruction is offered in German so the applicant should express the willingness to quickly learn the language. We also expect very good teaching skills.

Applicants for this position should have an excellent track record in the field, first experiences with acquiring external funding and collaboration in national and international research programs. Active participation in the acquisition of external funding is expected and an appropriate participation in the faculty's self-administration is required.

Conditions for appointment are a completed course of studies at a university, pedagogical aptitude, doctorate and additional academic achievements (§51 LHG).

The appointment has an initial duration of three years and will be extended by further three years after a positive evaluation. A final evaluation after six years will be the basis for the intended promotion to a tenured Full Professor position (W3 o.L.) based on the quality management concept of the University of Ulm ([www.uni-ulm.de/qualitaetssicherungskonzept](http://www.uni-ulm.de/qualitaetssicherungskonzept)).

Ulm University is committed to increasing the share of women in research and teaching positions and therefore explicitly encourages female candidates to apply.
