

Travel Information for QuEBS 2011

Arriving by plane:

The nearest international airports are **Stuttgart (80km)**, **Munich (135km)**, and **Frankfurt (260km)**. Then, **Ulm** can be easily reached by train (ICE, EC and IC rail services): cost around 30-60 €.

From **Stuttgart** airport:

- Take S-Bahn (lines 2 or 3) to Stuttgart Hauptbahnhof (“main station”), and get off after ~ 30’
- Take a train to Ulm Hauptbahnhof. There are hourly direct ICE/IC/EC (high-speed trains, travel time around 50’) and RE (regional trains, around 60’)

From **Munich** airport:

- Take S-Bahn (lines 1 and 8) and get off at Munich Hauptbahnhof (“main station”) after ~ 45’
- Take a train to Ulm Hauptbahnhof. There are hourly direct ICE/IC/EC (high-speed trains, 80’) and RE (regional trains, 100’)

From **Frankfurt** airport:

- Walk to Frankfurt (Main) Fernbahnhof (10’ from the terminal)
- Take a train to Ulm Hauptbahnhof (“main station”). There are direct ICE (high-speed trains) every 60’ but for some of them you will have to change at Mannheim where connecting trains usually wait on the other side of the platform. Travel time is around 150’.

Arriving by train:

Ulm is located at the **ICE** (“high-speed”) railway track **München-Stuttgart**. The main railway station in Ulm, called “Ulm Hauptbahnhof”, is in the town center.

Arriving by car:

Ulm lies in the middle of southern Germany on the highway A8 (Stuttgart-Munich). Leave A8 at the exit **Ulm West** (*No. 62*). From there take the direction **Ulm** on the national road *B10*. Leave *B10* at the exit **Wissenschaftsstadt**. Follow the road until you can turn left to **Universität**. Turn left again at the next crossing to reach the parking area.

Once in Ulm:

Participants will be issued with a DING card allowing them to freely take any bus/tram in Ulm/Neu-Ulm city region, for the duration of the meeting. 
To get there from Ulm train station:

At the bus stop in front of the Ulm main train station (“Hauptbahnhof”), on the other side of the street, take the **tram 1** (direction Böfingen) and after around 10’ get off at **Ulm Donauhalle**. The Lago Hotel is then at a walking distance from the tram stop (4’).


Restaurant Am See:

...to Lago Hotel





To get there from Ulm train station:

The Ibis Hotel is at a walking distance (300m) from Ulm main train station (“Hauptbahnhof”). Once you leave the station, turn left and, following the main street, you are on “Olgastrasse”. Then, at the first crossing, turn again left and, on your right side, there is Ibis Hotel (in front of Ulm Theater).



To get the conference place from Ibis Hotel

There is a bus stop just outside Ibis Hotel. Take the **bus 3** (direction Wissenschaftsstadt or Science Park II or Universität Sud), which leaves every 10’. Get off at "**Botanischer Garten**" (after around 12’) and follow by walking the path shown in the local map to the **building N27**. The conference takes place at **Lecture Hall** (Multimedia Raum) on the ground floor.
