The topic to be investigated is:

"The role of myeloid-derived suppressor cells in trauma"

The project is part of the newly founded Collaborative Research Center "Danger Response, Disturbance Factors and Regenerative Potential after Acute Trauma" (SFB 1149) of Ulm University. Our laboratory is interested in the immunoregulatory functions of MDSCs, a population of immature myeloid cells suppressing innate and adaptive immune responses. The project will elucidate on cellular and molecular levels whether and how MDSCs change the immune response after traumatic injuries, such as blunt chest trauma and femur osteotomy. Ultimately, the aim is to determine whether interference with MDSC development is a possible therapeutic option after trauma induction.
