Entrance and admission requirements

1. Proof of a bachelor's degree with examinations in study programmes in psychology, computer science, cognitive science or any other programme at any higher education institution in Germany or abroad completed with an equivalent degree awarded after a minimum of three years of study and subject to a minimum three quarter match of the respective study contents.
2. Proof of adequate examination results are:
 - a bachelor's degree with an overall grade of 2.6 or better, or, if the degree has not yet been granted,
 - examination results showing an average of 2.9 or better based on 140 ECTS or more ECTS credit points by the application deadline.
3. Proof of adequate command of English:
Proof may be:
 - Proof of adequate command of English at level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
 - The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 570 (Paper-based TOEFL), 230 (Computer-based TOEFL), 88 (Internet-based TOEFL)
 - IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5 or any comparable proof.
 - Proof that the bachelor's or other degree programme was taught exclusively in English.

This does not apply to applicants who are native English speakers.

Selection of applicants is based on a ranking on the following criteria:

- The overall grad of bachelor's or equivalent degree or, if this has not yet been determined, the average grade of examination results taken by the application deadline;
- Proof of knowledge acquired in practical computing science (with programming in high-level programming languages) with 6 or more ECTS.
- Proof of participation in interdisciplinary projects whose content is relevant for the programme in Cognitive Systems or related work experience (minimum 6 months)
- Proof of substantial study and research periods abroad
- Proof of completion of courses whose subject-matter is relevant for the programme in Cognitive Systems.
