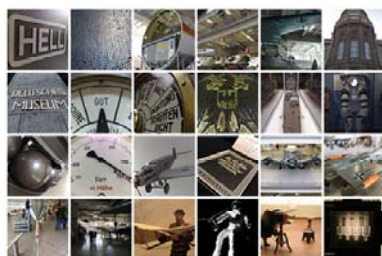




## Invitation to PhD students of the International Graduate School in Molecular Medicine Ulm and the M4M mentors

##### **Meeting in front of Ulm main station (Ulm Hbf) 7.50 am**

Regional train from Ulm to Munich: leaving Ulm at 8.12 am, arrival at Munich Hbf 10.22, arrival at the museum approx. 10.45

Return train leaving Munich Hbf 18.33, arrival at Ulm Hbf 20.38 pm

##### **Own contribution: 7,50 €**

(including the train ride and the museum's fee as well as a one day accident and casualty insurance) – it will be collected during the train ride to Munich (if possible prepare the amount exactly).

Not included is any food or drinks.
