10.37 train from Ulm Central Station to Blaubeuren (RB Blaubeuren Ehingen)

10.55 arrival at Blaubeuren Station, mentor Frank Luwe will welcome you

11.10 Rad Wanderbus to Sontheim from Blaubeuren Station

What are the costs

Your study ticket is valid. Entrance to the cave is about 2 Euro pP. Either you take your lunchbox and your drinks or you buy your meal and drinks at the cafeteria outside the cave.
