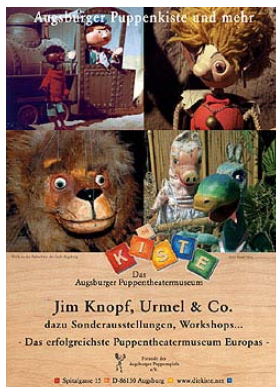
Samstag, 4. Februar 2012: „Exkursion nach Augsburg“

Saturday, February 4th, 2012 “Excursion to Augsburg”



We invite you to join an excursion to one of Germany's oldest cities which was founded by the Romans between 8 BC and 37 AD. With around 270.000 inhabitants Augsburg is the third largest city of Bavaria. It is a town worth seeing because it is a Renaissance town.

We take a train from Ulm mainstation. In Augsburg at first we will take part in a tour “2000 years of history in two hours” with an English speaking guide which will start at the Rathausplatz. Also the famous Golden Hall in the City Hall will be visited during the guided tour as well as the “Fuggerei”, the world's oldest social housing quarter founded by Jacob Fugger in 1521.



After a midday break we meet again at the Rathausplatz to walk together to the museum of the “Augsburger Puppenkiste”. Likely nearly all German children (and adults) know and like the marionettes which are exhibited there like “Jim Knopf and Lukas the train driver”, “Urmel from the ice” and “small king Kallewirsch” because they are all stars of children's TV at least in Germany, a very nice piece of German culture. Currently there is also a special exhibition for the 10th anniversary of the museum with international stars like the Rolling Stones, the Beatles (all as marionettes) congratulating the museum. Afterwards we take the train back to Ulm.

Some organisational details about the excursion on Feb. 4th, 2012

Time schedule

We will meet in front of Ulm main station's InterCityHotel at 9.05am and then take the regional train starting at 9.24am from Ulm main station, likely platform 25. We will return at 6.39pm.

Eating and drinking

After the guided tour you could for example go to the "Stadtmarkt", a market hall where also lunch snacks are offered, open until 2pm. Or you bring something to eat and drink with you. There is also a café in the "Augsburger Puppenkiste".

Please make sure to wear good shoes (it could be slippery in case of cold weather) and warm clothes because we will walk a lot outside.

Own contribution: 11,00 €

including transport by train (Bayerticket), guided city tour, entrance fees to the Fuggerei, the Golden Hall and the Augsburger Puppenkiste as well as a one-day casualty and accident insurance – not included is any food or drinks.

It will be collected during the ride – if possible prepare the amount exactly.

Binding registration
