



Invitation to PhD students of the International Graduate School in Molecular Medicine Ulm and the M4M mentors

“Schweizexkursion: Rheinfall und Zürich / Excursion to Switzerland: Rheinfall and Zurich“

Saturday, June 19th, 2010



We invite the PhD students of the International Graduate School in Molecular Medicine of Ulm University and the M4M mentors to join the excursion to Switzerland. We will at first visit one of Europe's largest waterfalls, the Rheinfall near Schaffhausen. Then our tour will lead us to the largest city of Switzerland: Zurich (around 380.000 inhabitants). A city

guide will show on a walk for 2 hours all the important places of interest of the historic city centre. Afterwards you will have the chance to discover the city on your own until we will leave Zurich in the evening.



Some organisational details about the excursion on June 19th, 2010

Meeting at Ulm main station (Ulm Hbf) in front of the InterCityHotel entrance at 7.00 am

We take a coach starting at 7.15 am from Ulm ZOB (Central bus station).

We will arrive at the Rheinfall approx. at 10.15 am and will stay there (no entrance fee) for one hour until the bus departs at 11.15 am to Zurich.

The bus will probably use the parking area Sihlquai in Zurich, which is some minutes walk away from Zurich central station where our guided tour will start at 12.30 pm. The tour will end at 2.30 pm in the city. Then you may discover Zurich on your own.

Please be back at Sihlquai at 6.15 pm where the bus will start at 6.30 pm back to Ulm. We then take another route back in the South of Lake Constance, some kilometres also through Austria but without stop. In Ulm we will arrive approx. at 9 pm at the ZOB.

Please bring own snacks and drinks with you!

Important: Make sure to have your valid **passport** with you. If you have a residence permit for Germany you may enter Switzerland and Austria because of the Schengen Agreement without any special visa. If you have any doubts please ask the authorities in Ulm before the journey.

Attention: Switzerland is not part of the EU and has its own currency, the “Schweizer Franken” (Swiss franc, SFR or CHF). The exchange rate is around 1 CHF = 0,70 € or 1 € = 1,43 CHF. It is recommended to change some money before the journey. It could be that Zurich is a little bit more expensive than Ulm.

Own contribution: 12,00 €

(including bus ride and city walk in Zurich as well as a one day accident and casualty insurance) – it will be collected during the bus ride in the morning to the Rheinfall (if possible prepare the amount exactly).

Not included is any food or drinks.
