

# Participation in attendance events at Ulm University in times of the Corona pandemic - handout for students

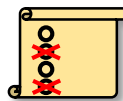

## Question 1: Am I generally allowed to enter Ulm University?

### Checklist 1:

- Have you had contact with an infected person in the last 14 days?
- Do you have typical symptoms of infection with the coronavirus, namely fever, dry cough, disturbance of the sense of taste or smell?
- Have you tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 with a rapid test?
- Have you tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 with a PCR test?

Yes



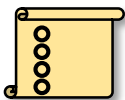
You answer one or more of the questions in checklist 1 with "Yes".  
→ **No entry.**

You may be infected with the coronavirus. Contact your family doctor. You need a negative PCR test, not older than 48 hours, to participate in practice events and examinations at Ulm University.

## Question 2: Do I need a negative rapid test to participate in a practical course?

### Checklist 2:

- Have you verifiably recovered from an infection with the Corona virus in the last 6 months?
- Have you verifiably already been fully vaccinated against the Corona virus (2nd vaccination more than 14 days ago)?

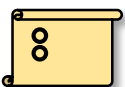

You answer one or more of the questions in checklist 2 with "Yes".  
→ **You do not need to take a rapid test.**

Present a proof document about their overcome infection or the complete vaccination at the beginning of the course. The lecturers will check the proof document. There is no compulsory testing before taking attendance examinations.

You answer one or more of the questions in checklist 2 with "No".  
→ **A prerequisite for participation in a practical course is proof of a negative rapid test.**

The rapid test must be carried out at a certified third party (e.g. COVID Rapid Test Centre Mensa Süd or other, pharmacy, family doctor). Arrange a test appointment in good time before the start of the course. Present proof of a negative rapid test no older than 24 hours at the start of the event. The teachers will check the proof document.
