

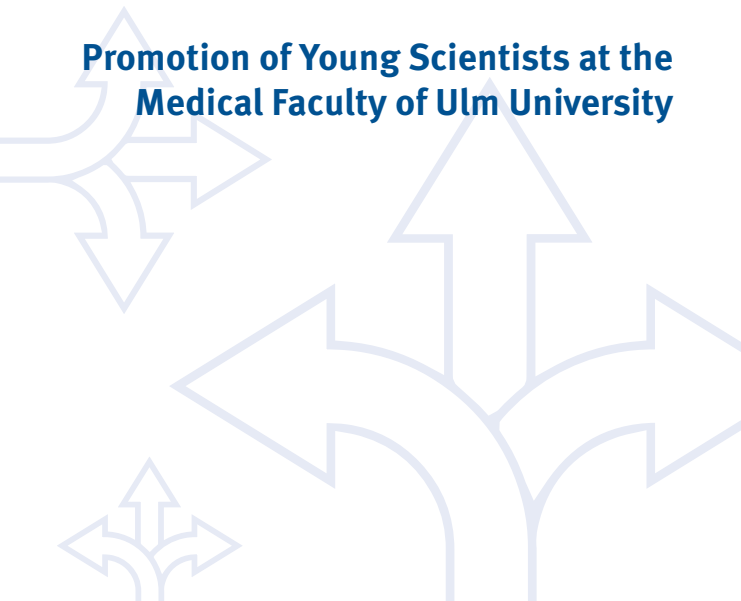

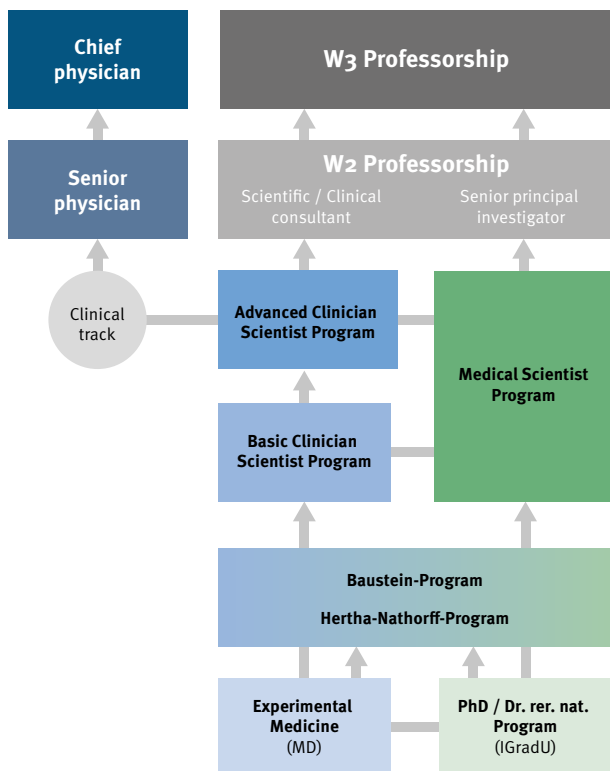




Promoting talent for science

Young talent in research is a key driver of innovation for gaining knowledge in medical research.

The Medical Faculty of Ulm University supports young scientists at the beginning and throughout their careers. To this end, the Medical Faculty has established numerous intramural funding and support programs for clinician and medical scientists.



... before the doctorate

MD program Experimental Medicine

Target group: medical students



- Experimental work (9 months)
- Prerequisite: semester off
- Call for applications in the summer and winter semesters
- Funding up to 40 scholarship holders per year

Funding by Medical Faculty:

doctoral scholarship of € 992/month for 10 months

International PhD Program in Molecular Medicine (IGradU)

Target group: natural science students with a Master's degree



- Structured international PhD/Dr. rer. nat. program over 3 to max. 4 years
- Admission 2x/year via selection procedure

... after the doctorate

Baustein-Program

Target group: physicians/scientists



- person-related project and start-up funding up to a maximum of 6 years after doctorate
- also for Clinician Scientists & Hertha Nathorff positions from the 2nd year onwards
- Funding period: 2 years + 1 extension year if necessary
- Call for proposals once a year

Funding by Medical Faculty: max. € 50,000/year/project

Medical Scientist Program (MSP)

Target group: physicians/scientists



- excellent scientific postdocs, 3 years after doctorate at the earliest
- Funding period: 3 + 3 years with interim evaluation
- Announcement once a year

Medical Scientist position (50%, E13)/doctoral student position/consumables and travel expenses

Funding by institution:

Medical Scientist position (50%, E13)/consumables and travel expenses

... after the doctorate

Basic Clinician Scientist Program (Basic CSP)

CASCADE 1.0

Target group: physicians during specialist training



- 50% release from clinical work
- Funding period: 3 years with interim evaluation
- lateral entry, also possible for physicians from the Hertha Nathorff Program
- Call for applications once a year

Funding by institution: Clinician Scientist position (50%)/consumables and travel expenses

Advanced Clinician Scientist Program (Advanced CSP)

CASCADE 2.0

Target group: medical specialists



- 50% release from clinical work
- Funding period: 3 years with interim evaluation
- Call for applications once a year

Clinician Scientist position (50%)/doctoral student position/consumables and travel expenses

Funding by institution:

Clinician Scientist position (50%)/consumables and travel expenses

Scientific Consultant Positions

(„Wissenschaftliche Oberärzt*innen-Stellen“)

Target group: medical specialists



- partial release from clinical work
- Duration max. 6 years with interim & final evaluation
- Management outside the hospital key for senior physicians
- Application possible at any time

Budget-neutral financing of the positions by the respective institution (TV-Ä3)

... for young female scientists after completing their studies

Hertha-Nathorff-Program (HNP) – Project funding

Target group: female physicians/scientists



- Funding is provided for personnel (WiHi) and material resources, as well as for the remuneration of test persons
- Project duration 6-12 months
- Announcement once a year

Funding by Medical Faculty:

max. € 15,000/year/project

... for young female scientists after their doctorate

Hertha-Nathorff-Program (HNP) – Scientific job promotion

Target group: female physicians/scientists



- Rotation/exempt/research positions for 1 year + possible extension
- Possibility of returning to work after parental leave/ Stay abroad
- Promotion of full-time and part-time employment (at least 50%)
- for female doctors: Possibility of lateral entry into the Clinician Scientist Program of the Medical Faculty
- Announcement once a year
