Note to Partner Institutions

In Germany, the study of “Human Medicine” is organized in three phases:

- Pre-clinical phase (year 1 and 2)
- Clinical phase (year 3 – 5)
- Practical phase (year 6)

The final year of study is a continuous period of full-time practical training – a total of 48 weeks – in several hospitals/clinics. In this practical year (= “PJ”), students work for 16 weeks in internal medicine, 16 weeks in surgery and 16 weeks in one of the other clinical-practical fields of their choice, both in the clinical facilities of Ulm University and in various academic teaching hospitals or at an academic teaching hospital of partner institution abroad.

It is important to stress, that these rotations follow a strict internal calendar and students are not free to choose their dates. These 4 month periods do not usually cover full calendar months, nor do they coincide with any given semester. If you accept a student for a clinical rotation, please make sure that you can arrange the chosen field during the dates indicated in the learning agreement or notify the student immediately, if adjustments in the time frame or field of specialization are required.

Note to Students

Even though our ERASMUS agreements are made out to cover a four months period of study at a given partner institution, you should not expect that our partners will be able to arrange for 4 months clinical rotations with the identical organizational framework that you are expecting here at Ulm or elsewhere in Germany. In other countries, the study of “Human Medicine” is often organized differently, and sometimes there may even be legal restrictions with respect to time and duration of clinical rotations or fields or you may be required to submit additional forms besides those required from the ERASMUS program. It is your responsibility to follow any instructions of your host institution. Even if you have received a learning agreement which has been approved by all parties, you should contact your host institution at least one month prior to the planned start of your rotation to make sure that all arrangements have been made or will be completed in due time.
