In general, <b>classes are taught in German</b> . Students' level of German should be minimum B1 in order to follow classes and take exams. Students who have only level A2 at the time of application may apply, but they are required to participate in the intensive German language prior to the beginning of their studies (September / March).							
Occasionally, certain classes in Bachelor programs may be offered in English. In addition, Ulm University offers a number of <b>Master programs taught in English</b> (http://www.uni-ulm.de/en/study/courses/programmes-of-study-in-english.html). Students wishing to take classes from these Master programs should have minimum level B1 in English <u>and</u> they should be Master level students at the time they start their studies in Ulm (i.e. they should either have formally completed a Bachelor degree <u>or</u> at least three years of undergraduate study <u>or</u> an equivalent of 180 ECTS). <b>Special regulations for Non-European nationals</b> : TOEFL ibt (88 minimum) or IELTS (6.5 minimum) is required if they want to take classes from English taught MSc programs!							
<b>Medical students</b> must have a minimum of B1 proficiency in German; for students wishing to sign up for <b>clinical rotations / medical electives</b> B2 is recommended.
