# MAP OF UNIVERSITY EAST



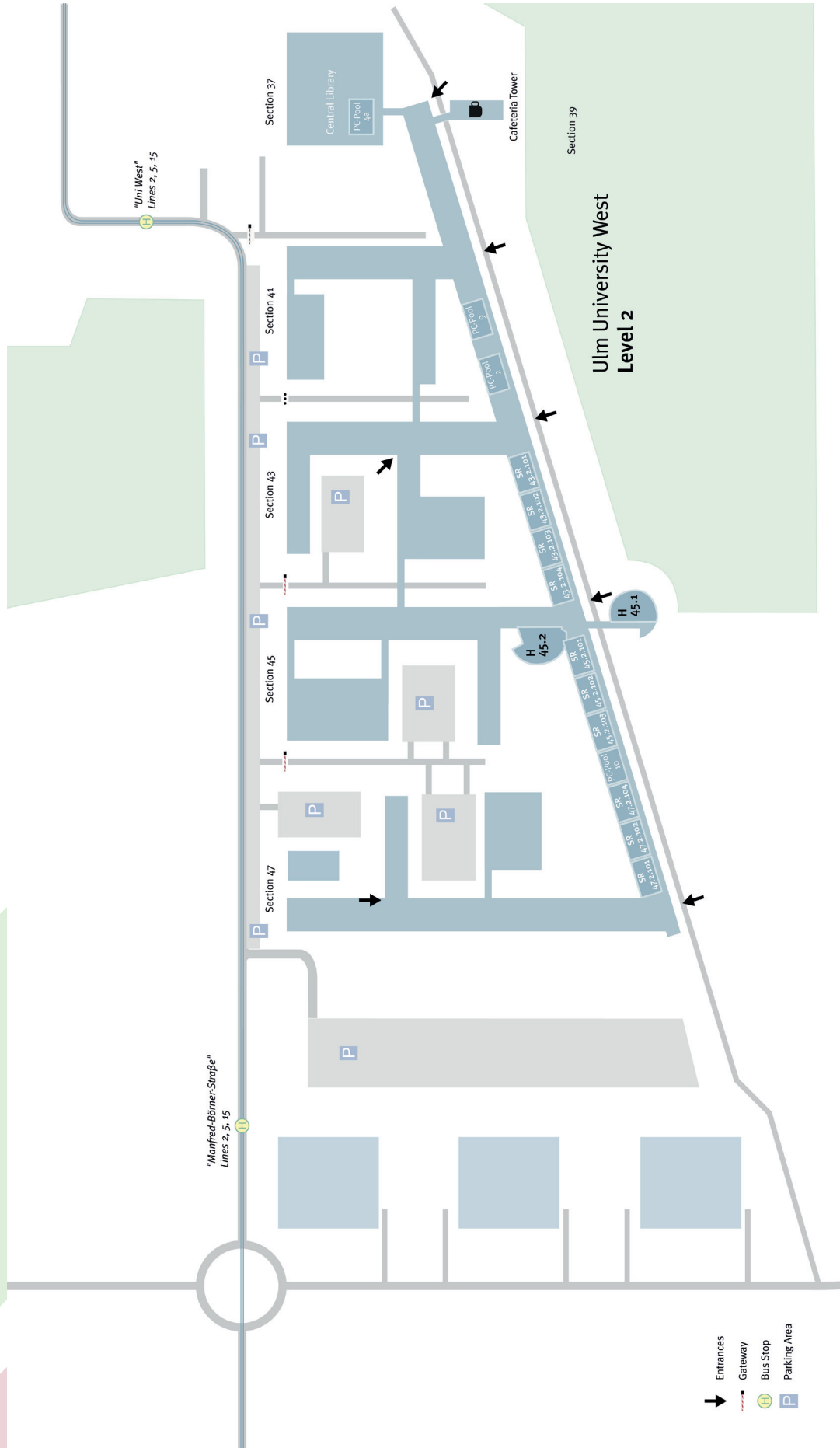

# MAP OF UNIVERSITY WEST



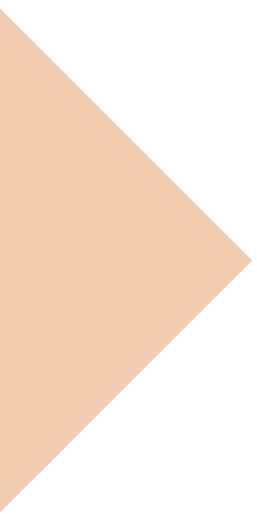
