The coordinator of the master programme Communication and Information Technology at Ulm University will reserve a room in the student residences maintained by the *Studierendenwerk Ulm* for you **once you have**

(1) submitted your housing request form and

(2) transferred a security deposit of 1,000 Euro (housing deposit, first rent, fees) to the *Studierendenwerk Ulm* within two weeks after having sent this housing request form.

If you fail to pay within the given time frame, your application for a room reservation is considered void.

You will be asked to take over the rental contract once you have come here, by signing a contract with the programme management and agreeing to a direct debit authorisation with the *Studierendenwerk Ulm*.

The minimum rental duration is one semester. You may withdraw from this contract (for costs incurring in this context please refer to the document *Essential Information*) by sending a request to ci-tech-admission@uni-ulm.de. Ulm University will terminate the contract if you fail to enrol in time.
