## Job Purpose/Role

Group Risk (GR) Operational Risk Management (ORM) department is responsible for managing operational and reputational risk in Allianz Group. Additionally the team sets the enterprise risk management and governance framework including the internal control system and manages the Group top risk assessment process. GR ORM has also developed an internal model for operational risk and is responsible for model update, model change and validation processes.

## Key Responsibilities

- Supporting group-wide status monitoring of the Integrated Risk and Control System (IRCS) e.g. by providing detailed results analysis, performing status reports and follow-ups, organizing group-wide conference calls
- Support in further development, testing and maintenance of the OpenPages GRC tool and updating of user manuals and training materials
- Drafting of internal papers and presentations
- Keeping internal communication up to date and update the Allianz Connect pages
- Supporting the team with various operational tasks, and analytics as needed
