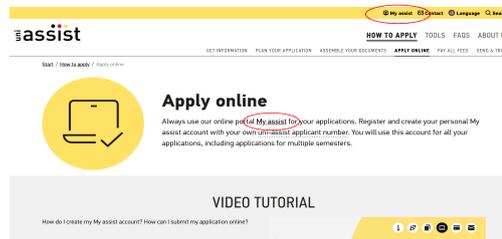


Hints for uni-assist

Getting started

When you click on the link to uni-assist provided on the web page of the admissions department you will see the following page. Next click on the red button **To My assist**. It is located right underneath a video tutorial which you can also watch. Alternatively, you can also click on “My assist“ in the border on the top right or in the text.



Next you will arrive at the following page (maybe you see it in German first – to switch to English click on “Sprache” in the upper right corner and select English). Start by registering. To register, click on **SIGN IN** and create a new account. If you are already registered, click on SIGN IN and enter your credentials.

After signing in, you will be led back to the page shown above. Next, type “Finance” in the search field at the top, select “Winter Semester 2026/27” as Semester, and select “Universität Ulm” as University. Press **SEARCH** and you should arrive at the following page. Click on **Select** to proceed.

If you cannot demonstrate achievements in an area, please enter 'no achievements acquired'.

Once you have answered all application-related questions, make sure to upload all necessary files.

Online-only application: For this application, the university accepts an online-only application for uni-assist's pre-check. Simply upload all the required documents to your My assist account. In some cases, you will need to submit further documents and/or officially certified copies to the university later.

Upload my documents

It appears that uni-assist displays a red exclamation mark at "Motivation letter and curriculum vitae" under the course of study-related questions even after successful upload. In this case, continue with the application and make sure to upload your documents at "Upload my documents".

According to the current admission regulations for this master's programme, you must write a motivation letter and provide a curriculum vitae as an entrance requirement. Note that you need to submit the application only online. We do not require authenticated copies of the documents for the application, and you do not need to send documents in paper form. (If you get admitted and decide to come to Ulm, you need to show the original documents at the time you enroll, which would be in early October at semester start.)
