The successful candidate (f/m/d) will particularly use established heart failure knockout mouse strains but also novel innovative and complementary models such as cardiac organoids. Moreover, novel knockout mouse models are to be established in this project. The development of own research ideas and scientific projects is highly appreciated and will be supported. The position is fully funded for 3 years by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) (QuE-MRT-Initiative).
