General information:

The joint field trip of the Universities Hannover, Hildesheim and Ulm focusses on the biological aspects of the habitat Mediterranean Sea. Students will experience the underwater life and related scientific methods while diving and will gather deep knowledge on ecology and biodiversity in the lab training. Students without diving license will be able to accomplish the Padi Open Water Diver. Certified divers will learn under water methods and collect samples for the lab during their dives.

Costs:

Accommodation/Rental car: 366 Euro per person Certified divers: lab training and eight dives + night dive: 689 Euro Dive beginners: lab training and eight dives + night snorkelling: 689 Euro + 112 Euro eLearning of dive theory Additional costs: flight and personal costs (food etc)
