Programme for the field teaching and field trips:

Mon. Sept. 6: Arrival of all participants in Arberwald Woodpecker House, Brennes 16, Bayerisch Eisenstein, Germany

Tue./Thu. Sept. 7 - 9: Excursions in the Bavarian Forest and to the border region Germany/Czech Republic

Fri. Sept. 10: Transfer to Horská Kvilda and visit of the pristine forest reserve “Boubín”

Sa. Sept. 11: Excursion into the core zone of the National Park Sumava (guided by experts from National Park Sumava)

Su. Sept. 12: Personal involvement in practical restoration of peatlands / Transfer to Dacice

Mo. Sept. 13: Wet meadows in South Bohemia and constructed wetlands

Tue. Sept. 14: Wetland restoration and management

We. Sept. 15: Traditional pond fishery, forest die back due to drought (evening: closing discussions)

Thu. Sept. 16: Departure and travel to the home country

All participants will be provided with digital teaching material prior the Summer School and are obliged to study these materials before the start of the field teaching and excursions. This specific measure is needed to comply with safety requirements.

Important notice: Be sure you have water proof hiking shoes and equipment as well as rubber boots for wetland restoration and excursions. During the excursions, each participant has to carry own food and drinks as there is no possibility to buy refreshments. However, food shopping will be possible on selected days.
