

Strong contribution of the Biology Department at the Research Day 2022 of the Baden-Württemberg Foundation.

With her presentation "The hidden world of the microbiome: How environmental changes affect animal and human health", Prof. Dr. Simone Sommer, Director of the Institute of Evolutionary Ecology and Conservation Genomics at the University of Ulm, delivered one of 4 exciting technical contributions at the Research Day 2022 of the Baden-Württemberg Foundation on June 30, 2022. Prof. Sommer also addressed the IMPALA project funded by the Baden-Württemberg Foundation, in which she is researching the influence of agricultural land use intensity on the health functions of microbiomes along the food chain together with Prof. Wilfert and Prof. Riedel (University of Ulm) and Prof. Schäfer (formerly University of Ulm).

With their poster on the IMPALA project, the team from the University of Ulm won one of 3 poster prizes, setting a strong tone for the University of Ulm among more than 100 other posters.
