

Information on the Complementary area | FSPOs 2022

Bachelor

In the Bachelor Biochemistry and Biology, at least 6 ECTS must be completed in the complementary area for the acquisition of interdisciplinary competences and language skills of free choice from the range offered by the Humboldt Study Center for Philosophy and Humanities and the Center for Languages and Philology (§ 4(4) FSPOs 2022). Beyond the 6 LP, further complementary modules can be taken according to the definition below.

Master

In the Master Biochemistry and Biology, modules of at least 9 ECTS must be completed in the complementary area (§ 5(1) FSPOs 2022).

Definition Complementary modules (§ 4(3) General framework – ASPO 2022)

Complementary modules are freely chosen outside the respective degree programme. Provided that there is no restriction for reasons of capacity or knowledge transfer, the complementary area includes all modules of the bachelor's and master's degree programmes at Ulm University as well as modules for the acquisition of interdisciplinary competences and language skills (Additive Key Qualifications - ASQ), unless they are already allocated as elective modules in the subject-specific degree programme.
