Institute seminars only qualify, if an external speaker gives a talk of 45 minutes or longer.

<sup>2</sup> The lecture host is the person who invited the speaker to present the talk at Ulm University. Typically the host will introduce the speaker at the beginning of the talk and typically the host is a Professor at Ulm University. The signature should be obtained immediately after the end of the scientific discussion that follows the lecture.
