Dear students,

Teaching will start on April 19th 2021. Due to the Corona pandemic, this semester will also start as an online-only semester. ### **Update on examinations**

*The following applies to Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes:*

Ulm University will continue to make arrangements for dealing with the effects of the corona pandemic on study and examination operations in the summer semester 2021, in particular to ensure that all necessary courses of the degree programs offered by Ulm University can be taken in time. In particular, Ulm University will introduce online examinations. The current corona regulations for the summer semester 2021 will be published on the relevant websites of Ulm University in good time before the start of the examination period of the summer semester. The examination period in the summer semester 2021 extends over the entire summer semester until the first week of lectures of the winter semester 2021/22.

The examination dates and forms will be announced in good time (with an appropriate period for preparation). It applies that all written examinations are offered openly in the examination format of written examinations and students can thereby withdraw from written examinations without stating an important reason up to one calendar day before the examination date at the latest. This also applies to oral examinations.

*The following applies to the degree programs in human medicine and dentistry:*

Students are informed about examinations - including examination formats - by the respective examination schedule. This will probably be available in full at the beginning of the lecture period.

### **Examination deadlines**

For students who are enrolled in a degree program in the summer semester 2020 or in the winter semester 2020/2021, the deadlines for the completion of subject-specific course and examination work in this degree program will be extended by one semester for each semester.
