




What are the differences?



Public Health Insurance Coverage



- Medical
- Dental
- Vision
- Hospitalization
- Pharmaceuticals, bandages, devices, treatments, testing
- Preventative medicine check-ups and screenings
- Health resorts (Kur)
- Paid sick leave
- Long term nursing care



Insurance Card

- Direct billing
- Chip saves personal information
- Works with all types of healthcare providers (dentists, doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, etc.)
- Works across Europe (with some caveats)



Copays in the Public Healthcare System

Token Payments

Examples of copayments:

Medication: € 5-10

Transport: € 5-10

Hospital stays: € 10/day, up to 28 days

 Medical devices and treatments: € 10

Those under 18 are only responsible for transport copays

Premiums from 01.10.2024



• **Health insurance:** €87.38 a month

• Additional contribution: €10.26 a month

Long-term care insurance: €29.07 a month

For those over 23 without children €34.20 a month

■ → 126.71 / 131.84 EUR per month

- Student membership is only possible if you are under 30 years of age
- Premiums are deducted on the 15th of the following month


Public vs Private Health Insurance

- No physical/medical history doesn't matter
- Preexisting conditions are covered
- Direct billing
- Comprehensive coverage
- No percentage copays, lifetime limits, annual deductibles
- Free choice of healthcare providers
- Family members are also covered for free
- Premiums don't rise with age
- Non-profit & lower administrative costs




