

## Selection criteria of the additional aptitude quota (*zusätzliche Eignungsquote*; short: ZEQ)

The allocation of places is based on a ranking list in which a maximum of 100 ranking points can be achieved:

Criteria Weighting							
WT	TMS	Vocational training	Work experience	Service	Prizes	Total	
45	50	2	1	1	1	100	SuSe2020 and WiSe 20/21
30	60	4	2	2	2	100	SuSe2020 and WiSe 21/22

### Waiting time (*Wartezeit*) – a maximum of 45 (30) ranking points

The following formula is used to calculate the ranking points *Points<sub>Waiting Time</sub>*:

$$Points_{Waiting Time} = \frac{(gewicht)_g}{15} * WT_A$$

The following applies:  $(gewicht)_w = 45 (30)$

$WT_A$  = the applicant's  $A$  waiting time in semesters, with values  $> 15$  being capped to the value 15.

### TMS – a maximum of 50 (60) ranking points

The points achieved by the applicant *Points<sub>TMS<sub>A</sub></sub>* are calculated as follows:

$$Points_{TMS_A} = \frac{TMS\ weight}{2} + \frac{TMS\ standard\ score\ B-100}{10} * \frac{TMS\ weight}{6}$$

The following applies: 0 points for TMS standard score (*Standardwert*)  $< 70$

$TMS_{weight} = 50 (60)$

$TMS\ standard\ score_A$  is the result that the applicant achieved in the TMS.

### Completed vocational training/work experience

**One or more** recognised vocational trainings yield 2 (4) ranking points.

**One or more** work experiences of at least **one year** each following the vocational training yield 1 (2) ranking points.

### Services/voluntary work

**One or more** recognised services/voluntary work yield 1 (2) ranking points.

### Prizes

**One or more** recognised prizes yield 1 (2) ranking points.
