The higher education institutions in the state of Baden-Württemberg charge international students tuition fees of EUR 1,500 per semester and fees of EUR 650 per semester for a second degree programme. According to section 3 of the federal state act on tuition fees in higher education (Landeshochschulgebührengesetz, LHGebG), international students who are not citizens of an EU/EEA country are liable to pay fees.

As an international student, you are generally liable to pay fees. However, the law provides for exceptions and exemptions. If you fulfil the requirements and provide us with proof of this in good time before enrolment or reregistration, you do not have to pay the tuition fee.

If one of the exemptions listed below applies to you and you can prove this with the relevant documents and evidence, please send this form by email (certified copies of evidence must be sent by post) before the start of the lecture period of the semester in question to:

- I have a disability within the meaning of section 2 of the Ninth Book of the German Social Code, which significantly impairs my studies.

We can only process your application if you submit the above-mentioned documents in the required form. If we do not receive any documents from you in a timely manner that justify an exception or exemption from the obligation to pay fees according to section 6 or section 8 para. 4 LHGebG, we assume that you are liable to pay fees as an international student or second degree student.

Electronic procedure

Ulm University carries out the procedure for charging tuition fees electronically. In particular, hearings, notifications and decisions relating to the charging of fees as well as the notification of administrative acts (notices) are carried out electronically.

Duration of the exemption from the obligation to pay fees for international students

Any exemption from tuition fees only applies provisionally for the duration of the validity of your documents. Please submit a new application and a certified copy of the updated supporting documents immediately after the expiry of the validity of your supporting documents. Please observe the re-registration deadlines. You can only re-register free of tuition fees once the application has been submitted and processed. We therefore recommend that you submit the follow-up application for the summer semester before 1 February and for the winter semester before 1 August.

Reimbursement

The reimbursement of tuition fees already paid may be considered in particular

- if the conditions for a statutory exception/exemption already existed at the time of enrolment or reregistration, but could not be proven through no fault of your own,
- if the conditions for a statutory exception/exemption are met within one month of the start of the lecture period and you claim them immediately within the month.

Translations

Documents are accepted in German or English.

Translations must be carried out by a sworn or authorised or publicly appointed translator. The translation must be submitted to the University with the translator's original stamp and signature.
